Canary Care – Starting out

- We started out as a B2C focused company
 - designed for families of older vulnerable people living alone
 - at the point that they're not on anyone's radar
 - Important to keep their independence
 - early warning system and to check on wellbeing
- Various examples of where we've helped
 - onset of Dementia
 - people with physical degenerative conditions
 - mobility issues & those at risk of falling
 - safety and wellbeing
- Benefits
 - having a window/view in on a loved ones life
 - no unwelcome intrusions on their lives
 - brings reassurance for all
 - obvious avoidance of disrupting their lives
 - avoidance of costs associated with finding further care









Canary Care – B2C customers

Melanie's Story

- Melanie's family were customers from February 2015 until December 2020
- Diagnosed with Vascular Dementia
- Tried telecare and CCTV, but nothing really suited their personal needs
- Stayed at home for almost 6 years before going into full time care
- We've been working with B2C customers ever since
- Only really been the last 2 years or so that our B2B customers have started picking up on long term use.

Melanie's Story

<u>Canary – B2B customers</u>

- Short term assessments in Health & Social Care
 - Maslow's Hierarchy of Needs & ADL
- Reablement
- Rightsizing (Re-assessment of existing care packages)



- Waking/sleeping nights (if removed, provides evidence to support the decision and then also as a long-term backup, for alerting)
- Safeguarding (recording staff interactions, process adherence)
- Reducing costs of social / continuing care (reduced care visits)
- Passive Emergency Response (falls, purposeful wandering, security etc.)
- Keeping People At Home (cost avoidance/savings through carer support/ADL monitoring/response)
- Hospital Discharge and Hospital Avoidance (frequent flyers)

Canary Care – B2B customers

Powys County Council

- Mr A 80 year old gentleman living alone in Newtown
- Late stages of Dementia and has started to wander
- Found wandering by the Police during the night
- Mr A's children were very worried but wanted to keep him home for one last Christmas
- Social worker had heard of Canary which was installed
- The family remotely monitored Mr A and used rules & alerts as an early warning system
- Allowed Mr A to remain at home, independently for a further 10 weeks

Canary in Powys

In addition to the outcomes of independence the Canary installation gave Mr A and the reassurance it gave to his family, the delayed admission to a care home resulted in the following cost avoided savings:

£4,900

£260

Care Home Fee avoidance (10 weeks at £490pw) Purchase of Canary Premium Package

£40

£4,600

Ongoing Canary To Monitoring Fee

Total Cost Avoidance
