So many key safes

What should you consider when choosing a key safe?

- Temporary or permanent
- Capacity what does it need to hold?
- Security internal or external?
- Who will be using the key safe?



A temporary solution

Often used for hospital discharge if there is not enough time to fit a permanent key safe

Alternatively, used for void property turnaround

2 types available

- Portable key safe
- J5 key safe (different brackets available)

Idea being that once a permanent key safe is fitted, the temporary key safe can be returned to the discharge team to be used again



Classic key safes

Often used internally, for example sheltered housing complexes where security is not a requirement

Products are discreet, cost effective and reliable

2 types available

- Slimline key safe
- Permanent key safe


